

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM NATION
(Approving Quijotoa Trading Post Lease Modification)

1 WHEREAS, the Gu Achi District Council did by Resolution No. 487-02 approve
2 execution of a lease for the Quijotoa Trading Post with Mrs. William
3 Parsons; and
4 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed the lease and
5 approves thereof.
6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Council that it does here-
7 by authorize and direct the Chairman and other appropriate officers of
8 the Tohono O'odham tribe to execute the lease on behalf of the Tribe
9 substantially in the form submitted to this meeting.

11 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 7th
12 day of July, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
13 1,581.5 for; -0- against; 58.5 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the
14 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitu-
15 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
16 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
17 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
18 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


