1	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation has received advice from the Bureau of
2		Indian Affairs ("BIA") of the allocation of \$197,000 for FY-87, an
3	a Harris	increase of \$63,000 over FY-86, for the Housing Improvement Program
4		("HIP"); and
5 6	WHEREAS,	the foregoing allocation was based upon a 1985 Consolidated Housing
7		Inventory prepared by the BIA which was by Council Resolution No.
8		357-87 found to be only provisional because it did not accurately re-
9		flect the actual housing needs of the Nation; and
10	WHEREAS,	the BIA has advised the Nation that it is proposing to change the
11		eligibility requirements for the program, and proposes, beginning with
12		FY 1988, to limit distributions of HIP funding to the elderly and/or
13		handicapped population of each Indian tribe; and

15	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council has in the past established a standing policy
16		allocating all HIP funds for the construction of new homes and author-
17		izing the Papago Housing Authority to administer the Nation's HIP
18		program pursuant to the provision of P.L. 93-638; and
19	WHEREAS,	the Housing Committee has recommended that, in order to more
20 21	9 19 m	effectively meet the needs of individual members of the Nation and
22		their families with exceptionally low incomes or no income at all,
23		particularly those who are elderly or handicapped, it is necessary for
24		the Nation to implement a new HIP program and policy which will
25		provide financial assistance, under BIA "Category A," for emergency
26		repairs and additions to existing substandard housing and, under BIA
27		"Category B," for the repair, renovation and/or enlargement of
28		structurally sound but deteriorating dwellings which can economically

1	WHEREAS, the Housing Committee has determined that in order to effectively put						
	in place such a new HIP program and policy, it will be necessary for						
	the Nation to make a new assessment of housing needs in order to						
1	update and complete the 1985 Consolidated Housing Inventory prepared						
2	by the BIA and to specifically identify the housing needs of the						
3	Nation's elderly and handicapped population; and						
4	WHEREAS, the Council concurs in the Housing Committee's recommendation.						
5 6	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council that it does hereby direct that a						
7	new office be established, at least initially within the Planning						
8	Department of the Nation, to be known as the "HIP Program," and						
9	initially to be staffed by a single director, which shall immediately						
0	undertake and complete a HIP housing needs assessment for the Nation						
1	and recommend to the Housing Committee and the Council a HIP funding						
2	distribution system which will provide for the most effective						
3	financial assistance to the most needy members of the Nation
