

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Report on HUD - HIP)

RES. NO. 241-87

1 WHEREAS, the Housing Committe did present a recommendation to the Tohono
2 O'odham Legislative Council regarding the creation of a HIP Office;
3 and

4 WHEREAS, it was further recommended that the HIP funds be used to provide
5 assistance under BIA category A & B for emergency repairs, additions
6 and repairs, renovations and/or enlargement of structurally sound
7 but deteriorating dwellings; and

8 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did not accept this recommenda-
9 tion, since the HIP monies are currently used to construct complete
10 houses; and


11 WHEREAS, this program, by contract, is carried out by the Tohono O'odham
12 Housing Authority; and

13 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council needs to hear what the status
14 of the current HUD and HIP Programs are.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does
16 hereby set a special meeting at the end of the month to get a full
17 status report on HUD and HIP.

20 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 7th
21 day of July, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
22 1,427.0 for; 213.0 against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the
23 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (b) of Article VI of the Constitu-
24 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
