

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(U.S. Department of Agriculture Grain Request Addressing the
Drought Conditions on the Tohono O'Odham Nation)

RES. NO. 249-87

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is experiencing a lengthy spell of dry, hot
2 weather; and

3 WHEREAS, cattle are dying due to lack of edible plants and water on the range;
4 and

5 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council has been informed about
6 possible assistance available from the U.S. Department of Agriculture
7 in the form of grain; and


8 WHEREAS, the grain is free but will involve cost for transportation and pro-
9 cess of mixing it.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
11 directs that efforts be made to assist the cattle industry through
12 this drought season.

13 AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council does
14 hereby direct the officers of the Council, Agriculture Extension Pro-
15 gram and the Agriculture Committee to explore the possibility of
16 acquiring some grain from the U.S. Department of Agriculture to be
17 made available to the cattle owners of the Tohono O'Odham Nation.

18 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on
19 the 10th day of July, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a
20 vote of 1,523.0 for; -0- against; 117.0 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to
21 the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (c)(2) of Article VI of the
22 Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
23 on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
24 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
25 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
