

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Emergency Feed Grain Request)

RES. NO. 255-87


1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is experiencing a severe drought which has
2 caused critical shortages of livestock feed and threatens the economic
3 existence of its livestock industry; and

4 WHEREAS, this Council has been informed that a program for emergency feed grain
5 exists involving the Departments of the Interior and Agriculture.


6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman or other appropriate officers
7 of the Nation is hereby authorized and directed forthwith to petition
8 the Superintendent of the Sells Agency to do everything necessary to
9 have the Tohono O'odham Nation declared an acute distress area for the
10 purpose of implementing an Indian Donation Feed Grain Program under
11 the provisions of Executive Order No. 11336 and Memorandum of
12 Understanding No. 5 between the Secretary of Agriculture and Interior,
13 or any other available emergency livestock feed program for
14 Indian-owned subsistence livestock on Indian owned lands within
15 designated acute distress areas.

18 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 17th
19 day of July, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
20 1,640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the
21 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitu-
22 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
23 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
24 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
25 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


