

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Education Legal Counsel Contract)

RES. NO. 264-87

- 1 WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 2(a) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
2 Nation gives the Council the power, through legislation, to employ
3 legal counsel for the protection and advancement of the rights of the
4 Tohono O'odham Nation. The choice of counsel and the fixing of fees
5 are subject to approval by the Secretary of the Interior, and
6 WHEREAS, by unanimous resolution the San Simo:n School Board (on December 11,
7 1986), the O'odham Education Committee (on December 18, 1986), and the
8 Tohono O'odham High School Board (on January 12, 1987) requested the
9 Tohono O'odham Legislative Council and the Nation's Chairman to "take
10 the steps that are necessary to have a written, BIA-approved education
11 legal counsel contract with Mark Ulmer," and
12
13 WHEREAS, the need for counsel specializing in education was discussed in
14 a) a meeting of the Human Resources Development Committee on June 26,
15 1987,
16 b) a joint meeting of the Human Resources Development Committee and
17 the Domestic Affairs Committee on July 14, 1987, and
18 c) a meeting of the Human Resources Development Committee on July 16,
19 1987.
20 Draft versions of an education legal counsel contract with Mark Ulmer
21 were reviewed in these meetings, and
22
23 WHEREAS, the final text of an education legal counsel contract (hereafter call
24 "Education Legal Counsel Contract") was reviewed and recommended for
25 adoption by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council in a joint meeting
26 of the Human Resources Development Committee and the Domestic Affairs
27 Committee on July 21, 1987. The recommended Education Legal Counsel
28 Contract is attached to this Resolution and incorporated herein by
29 reference, and
30
31 WHEREAS, signing of the Education Legal Counsel Contract pursuant to this
32 Resolution does not appropriate or obligate any funds of the Tohono
O'odham Nation or its subdivisions for the purposes of the Contract,
and


1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has a need for education legal counsel
2 services and the Education Legal Counsel Contract will meet that need.

3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation agrees to
4 contract with Mark Ulmer on the terms provided in the attached
5 Education Legal Counsel Contract.

6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman Enos J. Francisco, Jr. is authorized
7 and directed to sign the Education Legal Counsel Contract on behalf of
8 the Tohono O'odham Nation and obtain the required approval of the
9 Secretary of the Interior.



11 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 6th
12 day of August, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
13 1,121.5 for; 518.5 against; -0- not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the
14 powers vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) of Article VI of the Constitu-
15 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
16 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
17 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
18 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


1 Said Resolution was submitted for approval to the office of the Chairman of the


