2 trict Res. No. 31-84, and


3 WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee did review the Ordinance and recommends

7 of putting the Ordinance into effect.


8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does
9 hereby approve the San Lucy Curfew Ordinance and recognizes the wishes
10 of the San Lucy District that they are in full support of putting the
11 Ordinance into effect.

13 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 4th
14 day of August, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
15 1,582.0 for; -0- against; 58.0 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the
16 powers vested in the Council by Section 1(c)(1) of Article VI of the Constitu-
17 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
18 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
19 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
20 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


