


RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Substance Abuse/Alcoholism Prevention Education Program)

RES. NO. 276-87

1 WHEREAS, Substance and Alcohol abuse has consistently been identified as one
2 of the major problems affecting Tohono O'odham youth and communities,
3 and
4 WHEREAS, the Comprehensive Education Plan of the Tohono O'odham Nation
5 identifies as one of its goals the provision of substance and alcohol
6 abuse education programs in schools operating on the Tohono O'odham
7 Nation; and
8 WHEREAS, Federal dollars for substance and alcohol abuse education program
9 have become available for the Papago Agency Education Office, BIA;

12 WHEREAS, the Education Committee of the Tohono O'odham Nation approved a
13 contract proposal to contract for money to plan and make available
14 substance and alcohol abuse education training and materials to
15 teachers, counselors, parents and community members; and

17 WHEREAS, the contracting of substance and alcohol abuse program dollars, P.L.
18 99-500 would assist in the attainment of goals and objectives identi-
19 fied in the Tribal Action Plan for substance and alcohol abuse
20 programs.
21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
22 does approve the 638 contract proposal which would provide funds to
23 plan, implement and evaluate substance and alcohol abuse education
24 programs.

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and the Treasurer of
27 the Tohono O'odham Nation are hereby authorized to negotiate and
28 execute this contract and any amendments thereto for the duration of
29 the contract, provided however, that any amendments effecting the
30 funding or funding levels to the contract shall be submitted for
31 further prior approval by this Council.


The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 5th day of August, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,402.0 for; -0- against; 238.0 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




