(Tabling Disenrollment of Rebecca Acunia)

RES. NO. 27-87

1 WHEREAS, the case of Rebecca Acunia was brought before the Tohono O'Odham
2 Legislative Council; and

3 WHEREAS, during the hearing the parents of Rebecca Acunia did indicate a strong
4 desire to have her remain a member of the Tohono O'Odham Nation; and

5 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council did consider all statements
6 made by all parties involved.



8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the matter involving Rebecca Acunia is
9 hereby tabled until all documents are processed to relinquish her mem-
10 bership in the Gila River Nation.

11 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 12th
12 day of January, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
13 1561.0 for; 79.0 against; -0- not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers
14 vested in the Council by Section 1(a)(h) of Article VI of the Constitution of
15 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,
1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
1934 (48 Stat. 984).
