

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Economic Development Funds - Sells District)

RES. NO. 294-87

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 3rd day of December 1986, did repeal
2 the Nation's Chairman's veto of Resolution No. 516-86; and

3 WHEREAS, by the same Resolution No. 516-86, each of the eleven (11) districts
4 were allocated \$100,000.00 for the purpose of economic development
5 only; and

6 WHEREAS, it is now the intent of the Sells District Council to extract that
7 amount from the Individual Indian Monies Account; and


8 WHEREAS, that amount will be deposited into a commercial bank of the Sells
9 District's choice; and

10 WHEREAS, it is also the intent of the Sells District Council to authorize the
11 District Treasurer to seek advisement on how best to utilize the funds
12 for that purpose.


13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council does hereby approve
14 the withdrawal of the Sells District's share of the earmarked economic
15 development fund.

17 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 8th
18 day of September, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
19 of 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the
20 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the
21 Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
22 on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
23 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
24 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).



5 either approve or disapprove it within 48 hours of submittal.


