(Certifying the Appointment of Eugene Enis, Sr. as an Alternate
Delegate to the Annual NCAI Convention)

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council did certify the appointment of
2 the alternates to NCAI; and

3 WHEREAS, Councilmember Kenneth Chico, Sr. a certified member of the delegation
4 to NCAI will not be able to go; and

5 WHEREAS, Councilmember Johnson Jose will also not be able to attend the NCAI
6 Convention.

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8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
9 hereby certifies Eugene Enis, Sr. as a member of the delegation going
10 to the NCAI Convention in Tampa, Florida on September 19, 1987 and will
11 serve as an alternate delegate.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in the event other members cannot attend that
13 Councilmember Henry Ramon and Councilmember Fred Stevens will be on
14 standby to fill any other vacancies created.


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16 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 8th

January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


