

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(St. Francis Feast Police Protection)

RES. NO. 305-87

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did receive a presentation from  
2 the Chairman and members of the St. Francis Feast Committee; and

3 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did thoroughly discuss the ways  
4 in which the Nation could assist the committee in controlling such  
5 problems as the unlawful sale of alcohol and drugs at the Feast,  
6 violence which has occurred at other dances, stemming out of alcohol  
7 and drug abuse; and

8 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation cannot make a monetary donation to the  
9 October 4th, St. Francis Feast; and

10 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does support all other requests  
11 made by the St. Francis Committee; and

12 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council would like to assist by  
13 supporting the Law Enforcement Department in planning control of  
14 traffic, crowd and the unlawful sale of alcohol and drugs at the  
15 Feast.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Domestic Affairs Committee is hereby  
18 directed to meet with Chief Goodnight of the Tohono O'odham Police  
19 Department to discuss and devise a plan on how to maintain law and  
20 order during the October 4th, St. Francis Feast at Our Lady of the  
21 Sacred Heart Church, inclusive of the dance to be held at the  
22 feasthouse in Sells, Arizona.

24 AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that interested people are invited to participate in  
25 this discussion and such plan shall be reported to the Tohono O'odham  
26 Legislative Council on September 28, 1987.


28 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 10th

31 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (c)(2) of Article VI of the Constitu-  
32 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on  
January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act  
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




