

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY '87 Housing Improvement Program)

RES. NO. 307-87

1 WHEREAS, there is a continuing need for the construction of new homes on the
2 Tohono O'odham Reservation; and
3 WHEREAS, FY '87 funding is available through the Bureau of Indian Affairs
4 Housing Improvement Program in the amount of \$197,000.00 for the
5 construction of new homes; and
6 WHEREAS, 25 CFR Section 271 of the Federal Regulations provides the mechanism
7 for Indian Tribes to enter into P.L. 93-638 contracts with the Bureau
8 of Indian Affairs; and

10 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council desires to contract for the
11 Housing Improvement Program; and
12 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed and approved the
13 FY '87 Housing Improvement Program for the construction of five (5)
14 homes in the amount of \$197,000.00; and
15 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council intends to complete the housing
16 inventory submitted in FYE 1985, as stated in Tribal Resolution No.
17 357-85; and

19 WHEREAS, the funds to complete the inventory will be subcategorized and will be
20 in addition to the FYE 1987 allotment in the amount of \$13,500.00
21 additional funds.
22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does
23 hereby authorize the Tohono O'odham Housing Authority to enter into a
24 one year contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs for the
25 construction of five (5) new homes under the Housing Improvement
26 Program and to subcategorize the completion of the housing inventory
27 per Tribal Resolution No. 357-87. The contract term shall commence on
28 contract award and end 12 months after. The total set amount being
29 \$210,500.00.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Harriet Toro, Chairman, Austin Nunez, Vice Chairman
2 or Wayne Chico, Executive Director, Tohono O'odham Housing Authority
3 are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute these contracts and any
4 amendments thereto for the full term of the contracts.

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Housing Committee will be appraised
6 of any contract changes or amendments in documented form addressed to
7 the Committee Chairman in a reasonable time frame.



10 day of September, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
11 of 1,577.0 for; 63.0 against; -0- not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the
12 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitu-
13 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
14 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
15 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
16 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


