

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Accepting Legislative Housing Committee's Resolution #2-828-87;
regarding FY 1987-88 HIP Contract)

RES. NO. 308-87

1 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council reviewed Res. No. 2-828-87 pass by the Legis-
2 lative Housing Committee which supports the Housing Authority to
3 contract for funds available through the Bureau of Indian Affairs
4 Housing Improvement Program (HIP) for FY '87;and

6 WHEREAS, the Housing Committee's Resolution #2-828-87 also included ten (10)
7 recommendations for the Legislative Council to support. They
8 are:

- 9 1. Modify the Authority's resolution to include a provision under
10 "Be It Finally Resolved by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
11 Council, that in addition to authority granted to the Housing
12 Board Chairman, Vice Chairman and the Executive Director to
13 negotiate, execute and amend any part of the contract, that all
14 of the above-mentioned authority granted to officials of the
15 O'odham Housing Authority, be done with the express knowledge of
16 the Legislative Housing Committee and that all pertinent
17 information be provided to the Committee in documented format as
18 they occur within twenty-four (24) hours and addressed to
19 Chairman of the Legislative Housing Committee.
- 20 2. Inventory process numbered 1-8 either number 7, be changed to
21 Legislative Housing Committee, in place of Tribe or add another
22 line.
- 23 3. Committee recommendation, to supplement from any funding source
24 available, the Housing inventory budget to hire additional field
25 workers.
- 26 4. Certification of accounting procedures that meet accounting
27 procedure standards not included. Committee recommends this
28 information be provided.
- 29 5. Property Management system and record keeping of the Authority
30 not attached as specified under this provision. Committee
31 recommends this information be provided.
- 32 6. Advance payment request needs to be clarified in terms of
payments to contractor for actual work completed and/or material
purchase for this project.
7. Committee recommends language to be inserted after the word is
(upon contract award).
8. Clarification needs to be made in terms of under, "What title is
the contract to be entered into under Tohono O'odham Housing
Authority or Papago Housing Authority."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council to support and approve the intent of the Housing Committee Resolution #2-828-87.






