WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 91-87 the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did
authorize \$9,225 for the establishment of the Public Water Supply
Supervision Program; and

WHEREAS, such funding will expire as of September 30, 1987.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council hereby directs the Water Re-
source, the Public Water Supply Supervision Program to develop a
budget to cover the cost for the water testing for the villages and
present it to the Budget & Finance at their meeting on Monday.

The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 11th
day of September, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
of 1,353.5 for; 228.0 against; 58.5 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the
powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (i)(2) of Article VI of the Constitu-
tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




