

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Supporting the National Indian Health Board Discussion Paper
on issues related to SURAM/PL 93-638 Contracting)

RES. NO. 318-87

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is committed to the maximum availability of
2 health care services to its community members; and
3 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is desirous of efficient management and
4 administration of the health care service resources available to the
5 Nation; and

7 WHEREAS, the National Indian Health Board did convene a group of Tribal
8 Representatives from across the nation to develop discussion points on
9 issues related to SURAM (Service Unit Resource Allocation Methodology)
10 and other matters related to contracting under P. L. 93-638, the
11 Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act of 1975, which
12 affect the administration and management of health care services; and

14 WHEREAS, staff of the Tohono O'Odham Health Department did participate in this
15 activity and did contribute to the authorship of a discussion paper
16 which addresses numerous germane issues; and

18 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Health and Human Services Legislative Committee has
19 reviewed this discussion paper and recommends to the Tohono O'Odham
20 Legislative Council to seek endorsement from the National Congress of
21 American Indians (NCAI).

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council does
24 endorse the National Indian Health Board Discussion Paper on issues
25 related to SURAM/P. L. 93-638 Contracting, and seeks the support of
26 the National Congress of American Indians on this matter.

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council does support
29 the appropriate addressal of identified issues to the satisfaction of
30 collective Indian Nations.

32 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 15th
day of September, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
of 1581.5 for; -0- against; 58.5 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the
powers vested in the Council by Section 1(c)(2) of Article VI of the Constitu-
tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




