

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Supporting the draft National Indian Health Board Health Policy  
Group Discussion Paper on Tribal Consultation with IHS)

RES. NO. 319-87

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation recognizes its right to consult with the  
2 Indian Health Service on any and all matters related to the delivery  
3 of health care services to the O'Odham; and  
4  
5 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation recognizes that consultation represents  
6 communication as a two-way process between sovereigns; and  
7  
8 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation believes that such a process of  
9 communication can be enhanced and improved upon; and  
10  
11 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation does recognize and appreciate the efforts of  
12 the National Indian Health Board in convening a group of tribal  
13 representatives to address issues in consultation between the Tribes  
14 and Indian Health Services; and  
15  
16 WHEREAS, this group did generate a set of recommendations to improve  
17 Tribal/Indian Health Service consultation; and  
18  
19 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation does wholly support these recommendations;  
20 and

22 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Health & Human Service Legislative Committee has  
23 reviewed this Discussion Paper and recommends to the Tohono O'Odham  
24 Legislative Council to seek endorsement from the National Congress of  
25 American Indians (NCAI).

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council does  
28 request of the Indian Health Service the immediate consideration of  
29 these recommendations.  
30  
31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council supports the  
32 development and publication of implementation plans for incorporation  
of appropriate recommendations into the operational policy of the  
Indian Health Service.


