20	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will continue to provide						
21	Child Protective Services according to established Tohono O'Odham

24	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council does endors						
25	this resolution in opposition to BIA/IHS Memorandum of Agreement						
26	establishing minimum standards for Child Protective Services and seek						
27	support of the National Congress of American Indians on this matter.
