

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Amending Transaction Privilege Taxes Ordinance No. 3-81)

RES. NO. 338-87

1 WHEREAS, Section 342 of Public Law 99-591, 100 Stat. 3341-367, and 7 C.F.R.
2 § 246.3(d), provide that a state agency is ineligible to participate
3 in WIC programs authorized under Section 17 of the Child Nutrition Act
4 of 1966, 42 U.S.C. § 1786, if a state or local sales tax is collected
5 on WIC food purchases by a sovereign Indian tribe, the state agency
6 shall remain eligible only if vendors collecting such tax are
7 disqualified; and

8 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation operates a federally funded WIC Program
9 through the agencies of the Tohono O'odham Health Department and of a
10 State Plan administered by the Inter Tribal Council of Arizona, Inc.;;
11 and
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13 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council has determined that the Tohono O'odham Nation
14 and the WIC Program will be best served to exempt from the levy of
15 taxes imposed under the Transaction Privilege Taxes Ordinance, Ord.
16 No. 3-81, the sale of items purchased with food instruments issued
17 under section 17 of the Child Nutrition Act of 1966, as amended, 42
18 U.S.C. § 1786.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that
20 the Transaction Privilege Taxes Ordinance, Ord. No. 3-81, as amended
21 by Resolution No. 224-84, is hereby amended, effective September 30,
22 1987, by the addition of a new exemption, item (14), to subsection
23 5(B) thereof, namely:
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25 (14) The sale of items purchases with food instruments issued
26 under section 17 of the Child Nutrition Act of 1966, as
27 amended, 42 § 1786.
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29 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 15th
30 day of September, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
31 of 1,354.5 for; 227.0 against; 58.5 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the
32 powers vested in the Council by Section 1(d) and 2(b) of Article VI of the
Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
