1 WHEREAS, the San Lucy Representative did report to the Tohono O'Odham Legis-
2 lative Council the bids received on their Industrial Office Building;
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5 WHEREAS, other projects pursued by the San Lucy District is ongoing; and

6 WHEREAS, such projects regarding economic development and land purchases fall
7 under the jurisdiction of the Budget & Finance Committee and Commerce
8 Committee; and


9 WHEREAS, the Council needs an update on all these projects.

11 projects being pursued by San Lucy District is referred to the Budget
12 & Finance Committee and Commerce Committee.

15 Legislative Council with a listing of all projects plus the cost
16 projected.

17 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 12th
18 day of January, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
19 1523.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 117.0 absent, pursuant to the
20 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) & (b) of Article VI of the
21 Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




