

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL  
(Considering a Continuing Resolution)

DEFEATED  
LEGIS. ORDER NO. 359-87

1 WHEREAS, it is the final day of the fiscal year 1987 and a budget is not in  
2 place for the Nation; and  
3 WHEREAS, Resolution No. 356-87, "Adoption of the Tohono O'odham Nation's  
4 Budgets," has been processed to the Executive Branch; and  
5 WHEREAS, if the Chairman opts to veto the above-mentioned resolution, the  
6 Nation will not have funds with which to operate; and  
7 WHEREAS, a motion was made to consider the approval of a continuing resolution  
8 based on the figures submitted by the Executive Office.  
9  
10 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council hereby consider  
11 approving a continuing resolution based on the figures submitted by  
12 the executive office.  
13  
14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if Resolution No. 356-87, "Adoption of the Tohono  
15 O'odham Nation's Budgets," is vetoed by the Nation's Chairman, that  
16 Council reconvene tomorrow, October 01, 1987, to address the budget.

18 The foregoing order was defeated by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 30th day  
19 of September, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
20 380.0 for; 795.5 against; 464.5 not voting; and 04 absent, pursuant to the  
21 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitu-  
tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on  
January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act  
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
