3 of the newly appointed Judges; and


4 WHEREAS, the report may have information which should be held confidential by


10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that only the representatives of the Tohono O'Odham

14 of 1149.5 for; 426.5 against; 64.0 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the
15 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitu-
16 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
17 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
18 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
19 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


