1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has enacted Resolutions No.  
2 362-87, through 363-87; and  
3 WHEREAS, all resolutions must be forwarded to the Executive Branch for their  
4 reveiw; and  
5 WHEREAS, all the resolutions have a bearing on the FY '88 budgets; and  
6 WHEREAS, the Legislative Branch was notified by Enos Francisco, Jr., the Tohono  
7 O'odham Nation's Chairman, that all tribal funded programs are closed  
8 at the close of business today.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council  
11 shall go into recess today and shall reconvene October 02, 1987 at  
12 1:00 p.m.  
13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in the event that the Chambers are not available,  
14 that the Council will meet in the large conference room at the Multi  
15 Health Complex.


16 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 1st  
17 day of October, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
18 1,109.0 for; -0- against; 531.0 not voting; and 03 absent, pursuant to the  
19 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitu-  
20 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on  
21 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
22 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act  
23 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
