1 WHEREAS, the Legislative Committees under the Legislature are newly established
2 sub-divisions; and

3 WHEREAS, all Legislative Committees were directed to submit their draft
4 charters, by-laws, or authorities covering jurisdiction to the Rules
5 Committee by February 2, 1987; and


6 WHEREAS, most of the Committees have not been able to comply with this dead-
7 line.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the timeline for committee charters, by-
9 laws and jurisdiction shall be extended to May 1, 1987.


10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the said documents will undergo a thirty (30) day
11 review by the Rules Committee, who shall than make final recom-
12 mendations to the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council.

15 day of February, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
16 of 1363.5 for; 79.0 against; 197.5 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the
17 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (b) of Article VI of the Constitu-
18 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
19 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
20 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
21 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
