

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Gu Vo District FY '88 Budget)

RES. NO. 382-87

1 WHEREAS, the Gu Vo District Governing Council did by Res. 9/16-01-87 adopt a
2 budget in the amount of \$66,700.00 which does not exceed the amount
3 contained in their I.I.M. Account; and

4 WHEREAS, the resolution authorizes the communities of Ali Chugk and Pia Oik to
5 establish separate, interest bearing accounts for convenience and
6 better local management; and

7 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council concurs with and approves of
8 the budget as adopted by the Gu Vo District Governing Council.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that
10 it does hereby approve the FY '88 Budget of the Gu Vo District in the
11 amount of \$66,700.00 and does authorize expenditures thereof.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Communities of Ali Chugk and Pia Oik are
13 hereby authorized to transfer their budget's funds to establish
14 separate, interest bearing accounts.



20 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,
21 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
1934 (48 Stat. 984).

5 either approve or disapprove it within 48 hours of submittal.


