

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Tabling San Xavier District's Resolutions 9-87-16 and 9-87-17)

1 WHEREAS, the officers of the San Xavier District Council did submit two resolu-
2 tions, 9-87-16 and 9-87-17; and


3 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council deems it necessary to get the
4 input of the Water Resources Committee, attorneys and consultants and
5 have a thorough discussion on the resolutions in order to come up with
6 alternatives; and

7 WHEREAS, the San Xavier District Council did make a presentation with their
8 consultants regarding the recommendations in their resolutions.


9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
10 hereby tables the San Xavier District resolutions 9-87-16 and 9-87-17,
11 and the San Xavier Consultants, tribal consultants, Water Resources
12 Committee, and tribal attorney meet to discuss and analyze Plan 6 and
13 other alternatives, and if there is no concurrence then San Xavier can
14 bring the issue back to Council.

16 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 14th
17 day of October, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
18 976.5 for; 663.5 against; -0- not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the powers
19 vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitu- tion of
20 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,
21 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
22 (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
23 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
