

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(C.A.P. Construction Feasibility Studies Proposal)



1 WHEREAS, the Water Resource Committee has prepared a document entitled "A Pro-  
2 posal to Scope Potential Construction Opportunities for the Tohono  
3 O'odham Nation Associated with the CAP Project," a copy of which is  
4 attached hereto and made a part hereof; and  
5 WHEREAS, the work to be performed under this proposal will assist the Nation in  
6 determining its goals towards establishing its own construction  
7 company to complete work on the San Xavier Rehabilitation, the Schuk  
8 Toak new farm development, and the San Xavier farm development; and  
9 WHEREAS, it will cost approximately \$4,500.00 to perform the scope of work set  
10 forth in said proposal and due to the fact that the result of said  
11 proposal will assist the Nation in the subjugation of land, develop-  
12 ment of water resources and the construction of related facilities,  
13 the trust fund established by Public Law 97-293 could be used for this  
14 purpose; and

16 WHEREAS, the Water Resource Committee believes that it will be in the best  
17 interest of the Nation if the Legislative Council authorizes the work  
18 to be performed as set forth in said proposal and authorize the use of  
19 P.L. 97-293 trust funds to pay for said work performed.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that it does adopt  
22 the attached document entitled, "Proposal to Scope Potential  
23 Construction Opportunities for the Tohono O'odham Nation Associated  
24 with the CAP Project, " and authorizes the work set forth therein to  
25 be performed. It further authorizes the use of \$4,500.00 Of P.L.  
26 97-293 trust fund to be used for this purpose.  
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
28 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 15th  
29 day of October, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
30 1,233.0 for; 200.5 against; 206.5 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the  
31 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitu-  
32 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on  
January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act  
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




