- 18 6) Budgets regarding Water Projects


19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the San Lucy District proposed budgets be addressed

Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act  
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
