

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Amending Plan of Operation/Tohono O'odham Farming Authority)

RES. NO. 398-87

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did by Resolutions No. 91-79  
2 and 04-81, amend the Plan of Operation of the Tohono O'odham Farming  
3 Authority ("Authority") authorizing the Authority to obligate itself  
4 in an amount not to exceed the sum of \$1,000,000.00 in the aggregate  
5 in order to finance crops on the Authority's farms; and

6 WHEREAS, in order to obtain the increase acreage at Tohono O'odham and Vaiva Vo  
7 Farms the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did by Resolution 93-82,  
8 made another amendment to the Plan of Operation of the Tohono O'odham  
9 Farming Authority authorizing the Authority to obligate itself in an  
10 amount not to exceed the sum of \$1,500,000.00 in the aggregate in  
11 order to finance crops on the Authority's farms; and

12 WHEREAS, if the Nation purchases the Don Schramm Ranch for the Gila Bend  
13 Reservation pursuant to Public Law 99-503, it will be necessary for  
14 the Tohono O'odham Farming Authority to obtain considerable larger crop  
15 loans to finance crops on this additional amount of acreage under its  
16 jurisdiction; and

17 WHEREAS, the Management Board of the Authority has requested the Tohono O'odham  
18 Council for authority to obligate the Authority in the amount not to  
19 exceed the sum of \$3,500,000.00 in the aggregate in order to finance  
20 crops on the Tohono O'odham, Vaiva Vo farms and the Don Schramm Ranch.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that  
22 paragraph 8 of Section 6 B of the Plan of Operation of the Tohono  
23 O'odham Farming Authority be amended to read as follows:

27 8. " To execute guaranties. To make any guaranty respecting  
28 indebtedness, interest, contracts or other obligations lawfully  
29 entered into by or on behalf of the Authority, to the extent that  
30 such guaranty is made in pursuance of the purposes set forth in  
31 Section 4 of this title, provided that no such guaranty in excess  
32 of Two Hundred Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$200,000.00) shall be  
made without the prior written approval of the Tohono O'Odham  
Council, unless such guaranty is for the purpose of securing  
crop loans, in which event such guaranty, and the aggregate of  
other guaranties, shall not be in excess of \$3,500,000.00.

1 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 3rd  
2 day of November, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
3 of 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the  
4 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (b) of Article VI of the Constitu-  
5 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on  
6 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
7 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act  
8 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
