

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Adoption of the Livestock Ordinance)

RES. NO. 403-87 DEFEAT

1 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council reviewed the Livestock Ordinance presented by
2 the Domestic Affairs Committee; and

3 WHEREAS, the Council was informed that less than half of the 11 districts were
4 given an orientation on the proposed Livestock Ordinance; and

5 WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee informed the Council that it would be
6 in the best interest of the Tohono O'odham Nation to adopt the
7 Livestock Ordinance.
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9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that it hereby adopts
10 the livestock Ordinance as presented by the Domestic Affairs
11 Committee.
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13 The foregoing resolution was defeated by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 4th
14 day of November, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
15 of 296.5 for; 1,174.5 against; 169.0 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the
16 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (c) of Article VI of the Constitu-
17 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
18 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
19 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
20 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
