

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Title VII Transitional Bilingual Education Project Proposal)

RES. NO. 405-87

1 WHEREAS, the O'Odham Education Committee, Human Resource Development Committee
2 and the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council have approved and adopted
3 the Tohono O'Odham Education Standards which will guide the curriculum
4 development at all schools operating within the boundaries of the
5 Tohono O'Odham Nation; and

6 WHEREAS, the need for implementation of the adopted Standards is eminent if the
7 bilingual/bicultural educational goals and objectives of the Tohono
8 O'Odham Nation are to be achieved; and

10 WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Education, Washington, D.C. has requested for
11 proposals for Title VII, Bilingual Education Projects funding; and


12 WHEREAS, the O'Odham Education Department, Executive Education Committee, Human
13 Resource Development Committee and Budget & Finance Committee have
14 reviewed and recommend the approval of a proposal entitled "Tohono
15 O'Odham Bilingual Education Program Title VII Transitional Bilingual
16 Education Proposal" which would assist in the bilingual education
17 goals of the Tohono O'Odham Nation.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council does
20 hereby approve the submission of the proposal entitled Tohono O'Odham
21 Transitional Bilingual Education Project.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Treasurer of the
23 Tohono O'Odham Nation are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute
24 the grant and any amendments thereto for the duration of the grant,
25 provided however, that any amendments effecting the funding of the
26 grant shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.


28 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 5th
29 day of November, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
30 of 1523.5 for; 58.0 against; 58.5 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the
31 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (c)(2) of Article VI of the Constitu-
32 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


