NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council does hereby approve the submission of the proposal entitled Tohono O'Odham Transitional Bilingual Education Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Treasurer of the Tohono O'Odham Nation are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant and any amendments thereto for the duration of the grant, provided however, that any amendments effecting the funding of the grant shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the  $\frac{5th}{day}$  of November,  $\frac{1987}{1987}$ , at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  $\frac{1523.5}{19980}$  for;  $\frac{58.0}{19980}$  against;  $\frac{58.5}{19980}$  not voting; and  $\frac{01}{19980}$  absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (c)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
