

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Public Water Supply Supervision Program Budget FY '87-88)

RES. NO. 409-87

1 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council on November 5, 1987 reviewed the proposed
2 Public Water Supply Supervision Program budget in the amount of
3 \$72,026.00; and

4 WHEREAS, the appropriate Committee did review the proposed budget and have
5 referred it to the Legislative Council for their immediate action; and

6 WHEREAS, the intent of the proposal is to fulfill the Tohono O'Odham Nation
7 objective to comply with the Safe Drinking Water Act and to assume the
8 regulatory and enforcement role presently administered by EPA (see
9 attached Goals and Objectives).

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that it hereby
12 approves the Public Water Supply Supervision Program budget in the
13 amount of \$72,026.00 effective October 1, 1987 to September 30, 1988.


14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the funds to cover the budget come from the Tohono
15 O'Odham Nation Trust Fund.

16 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 5th
17 day of November, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
18 of 986.5 for; 451.5 against; 202.5 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the
19 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitu-
20 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
21 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
22 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
23 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
