


RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Modification of FY '88 Administrative Provisions Budget)


1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did adopt a budget for Admin-
2 istrative Provision for FY '88; and
3 WHEREAS, such budget did include a line item for water testing in the amount of
4 \$4,000.00; and
5 WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 409-87, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did
6 adopt a budget for the Public Water Supply Supervision Program, which
7 funds water testing.
8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the amount of \$4,000 for water testing be
9 transferred to the contingency line item in the Administrative
10 Provisions Budget for FY '88.

12 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 5th
13 day of November, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
14 of 1,256.0 for; 299.0 against; -0- not voting; and 85.0 absent, pursuant to the
15 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitu-
16 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
