

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Modification to Mining Department Budget)

RES. NO. 417-87

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Tribal Council established a Mining Office for the
2 Nation in Tucson in 1970; and

3 WHEREAS, the mining business of the Nation has been handled from this office
4 continually since then until the present; and


5 WHEREAS, the line item for the rent for the Mining Office was deleted from the
6 FY 1988 budget; and

7 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council wishes to keep the present
8 Mining Office open.



10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
11 approves a modification to the FY 1988 budget of the Mining Department
12 adding \$2,760.00 to the total to pay the rent for the Mining Office,
13 in Tucson, Arizona, this addition changes the total budget for the
14 Mining Department from \$55,326.00 to \$58,086.00 for FY 1988.

15 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 23rd.
16 day of November, 1987 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
17 1339.0 for; 242.5 against; 58.5 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the
18 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d) of Article VI of the Constitu-
19 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
20 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
21 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
22 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
