

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(United Way Funding FY-88)

RES. NO. 41-87

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating Juvenile Delinquency
2 Prevention Services under an agreement with United Way of Tucson; and

3 WHEREAS, such services for the youth have been successful and beneficial; and

4 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation does desire to enter into an agreement for
5 services during FY-88.


6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that
7 it does support and authorize the Tohono O'Odham Nation to enter into
8 an agreement with United Way of Tucson for Juvenile Delinquency
9 Prevention Services.

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that the
12 Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate the program in the
13 interim while negotiations are still being conducted and no executed
14 contract has been awarded by the United Way of Tucson Agency.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that Josiah
16 Moore, Chairman; Francisco Jose, Vice-Chairman; or Rosita N. Ruiz,
17 Acting Treasurer of the Tohono O'Odham Nation are hereby authorized to
18 negotiate and execute any and all contracts, amendments and documents
19 necessary to secure funding for the continued operation of the
20 Juvenile Delinquency Prevention Services.

23 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 4th
24 day of February, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
25 of 1360.0 for; -0- against; 69.0 not voting; and 211.0 absent, pursuant to the
26 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution
27 of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January
18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
