

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Interim Budget for Tohono O'Odham Aquatic Complex Operations)

1 WHEREAS, all funds for the operation and maintenance of the
2 Tohono O'Odham Aquatic Complex have been expended; and

3 WHEREAS, funds are being requested for maintenance purposes so as
4 to avoid the deterioration of the complex and equipment;
5 and


6 WHEREAS, joint agreements state that Save the Children Federation
7 and the Tohono O'Odham Nation would be responsible for
8 the maintenance and operation of the facilities once
9 built with Indian Oasis School District funds; and

10 WHEREAS, it will be to the advantage of all Tohono O'Odham to
11 keep this Recreational Complex in such a condition as to
12 insure the health and safety of its users.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham
14 Legislative Council does hereby approve an interim
15 emergency three month budget in the amount of \$8,154.44
16 for the purpose of maintaining the Tohono O'Odham
17 Aquatic Complex.


18 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
19 on the 7th day of December, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum
20 was present with a vote of 1,412.0 for; 84.5 against; 58.5 not
21 voting; and 85.0 absent; pursuant to the powers vested in the
22 Council by Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of
the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by
the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
