## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Adopting Administrative Plan for Health Department)

RES. NO. 421-87

- WHEREAS, Section 2 (a) of Article VII of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation mandates that the administration and management of the government be in accordance with an administrative plan adopted by the Legislative Council; and
- WHEREAS, the current Health Advisory Group, working with the Health Department, has developed and proposed for adoption the attached Administrative Plan which establishes a Health Department under the direction of a director, as well as a Health Board with certain designated powers; and
- WHEREAS, the Administrative Plan has been reviewed by the Health and Human Services Committee & Rules Committee and comes to the Council for review and action.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council does hereby adopt the attached Administrative Plan creating the Health Department of the Tohono O'Odham Nation.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any resolutions and ordinances of the Council the provisions of which are in conflict with the herein adopted Administrative Plan are hereby repealed and of no further force and effect.

The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 7th day of December, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,076.5 for; 505.0 against; 58.5 not voting; and 01 absent; pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (b) of Article VI and Section 2 (a) of Article VII of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
