- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council does hereby approve expenditures by the District Council of a sum not to exceed \$473,213.75 for the FY '88 Fiscal Year; provided that expenditures thereof be limited to line items included in the District's Interim Budget Request (dated October 01, 1987 - December 31, 1987) for currently existing programs (excluding equipment and vehicle purchases and consulting services) and staff positions only; provided further that authorization to spend funds is conditioned upon the District submitting a new budget for approval by the Budget & Finance Committee and this Council within thirty (30) days, which budget includes a detailed accounting of all expenditures previously made, specifically identified to line items contained in the Interim Budget Request and all sub-budgets and certified

L. 99-503 or by the San Lucy District with respect to expenditures which do not meet the requirements of P. L. 99-503.
