

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Interim FY '88 Funding for San Lucy District)

RES. NO. 450-87

1 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council did by Resolution No. 399-87
2 approve the FY '88 budget for the San Lucy District and
3 did approve an advance or loan, not to exceed
4 \$1,892,855.00 , to fund such budget, to be repaid from
5 Public Law 99-503 settlement funds; and

6 WHEREAS, the Nation did advance to the San Lucy District the sum
7 of \$473,213.75 pursuant to Resolution No. 399-87, which
8 amounts to one fourth (1/4) of the District's total
9 requested FY '88 budget; and

10 WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed its decision and did, by
11 Resolution No. 425-87, revoke Resolution No. 399-87 and
12 its approval of the San Lucy District's budget; and

13 WHEREAS, the Council upon further review of the budget of the San
14 Lucy District and of the attached Interim Budget
15 Request, has determined that the following action is in
16 the best interest of the District and the Nation.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council does hereby
18 approve expenditures by the District Council of a sum
19 not to exceed \$473,213.75 for the FY '88 Fiscal Year;
20 provided that expenditures thereof be limited to line
21 items included in the District's Interim Budget Request
22 (dated October 01, 1987 - December 31, 1987) for
23 currently existing programs (excluding equipment and
24 vehicle purchases and consulting services) and staff
25 positions only; provided further that this
26 authorization to spend funds is conditioned upon the
27 District submitting a new budget for approval by the
28 Budget & Finance Committee and this Council within
29 thirty (30) days, which budget includes a detailed
30 accounting of all expenditures previously made,
31 specifically identified to line items contained in the
32 Interim Budget Request and all sub-budgets and certified

by the Accounting Office of the Nation, and which budget segregates expenditures which are properly attributed to the District's purely governmental operations from those authorized under P.L. 99-503; and provided further that the Nation shall be reimbursed the sum of \$473,213.75 advanced to the San Lucy District, plus eight percent (8%) thereon, from the settlement funds made available pursuant to P. L. 99-503 or by the San Lucy District with respect to expenditures which do not meet the requirements of P. L. 99-503.

The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 18th day of December, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1461.0 for; 179.0 against; -0- not voting; and 03 absent; pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
