

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Law Enforcement FY '87)
AMENDMENT

RES. NO. 45-87

1 WHEREAS, The Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the Law Enforcement
2 under FY 1987 P.L. 93-638 contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs;
3 and

5 WHEREAS, any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the contract
6 shall be submitted for review and approval by the Tohono O'Odham
7 Legislative Council; and

8 WHEREAS, the passage of the "Anti Drug Abuse Act of 1986" allocated \$500,000.00
9 to the Tohono O'Odham Nation Law Enforcement for interdiction, en-
10 forcement, education and eradication; and


11 WHEREAS, an amendment has been submitted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation Law
12 Enforcement for review and approval

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
15 does hereby approve the amendment to the Tohono O'Odham Law Enforce-
16 ment contract.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman; Francisco Jose, Jr., Vice-
18 Chairman or Rosita Ruiz, Acting Treasurer of the Tohono O'Odham Nation
19 are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute this amendment



22 day of February, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
23 of 1480.5 for; 159.5 against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the
24 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution
25 of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January
26 18, 1986 and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs
27 (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
28 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
