RES. NO. 46-87

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council by Resolution No. 492-86 has
2 previously supported the submittal of an application for grant funds;
3 and

4 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation thru the Planning Department has prepared an
5 application to develop and implement a comprehensive Land Use and
6 Economic Development Plan to protect and enhance the quality of the
7 reservation resource base; and


8 WHEREAS, the Commerce Committee does have jurisdiction over this matter; and

9 WHEREAS, the proposed comprehensive Land Use and Economic Development Plan
10 should be reviewed by the District Councils.


12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Commerce Committee is hereby directed
13 to discuss the proposed comprehensive Land Use and Economic Develop-
14 ment Plan with the Districts for their input on this proposal.

15 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 4th
16 day of February, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
17 of 1084.0 for; 435.0 against; 121.0 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the
18 powers vested in the Council by Section 1(a)(b) of Article VI of the Constitu-
19 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
20 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
21 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
22 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
