6 3. Phyllis Cachora



9 prior meeting.


10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council will

17 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
