1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council did meet in closed session to
2 interview candidates for the part-time Judges position; and
3 WHEREAS, information distributed to the Council were retrieved; and
4 WHEREAS, some members of the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council want to know
5 the contents of the information.

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the information distributed and retrieved

8 yesterday is to be distributed to the membership of the Council.

9 The foregoing resolution was defeated by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 5th
10 day of February, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
11 of 735.0 for; 847.0 against; 58.0 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the
12 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitu-
13 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
14 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
15 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
16 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
