

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Proposing changes and additions in Memorandum of Agreement
between the Bureau of Indian Affairs and Indian Health Service)

RES. NO. 52-87

1 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) and Indian Health Service (IHS)
2 were mandated by the Omnibus Drug Act of 1986 to enter into Memorandum
3 of Agreement (MOA) to coordinate drug and alcohol abuse prevention
4 activities; and

6 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council passed Resolution No. 16-87 in-
7 dicating that the proposed MOA was insufficient and that the Tohono
8 O'Odham Nation intended to actively participate in the development of
9 the MOA.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the following comments developed by the
11 Tohono O'Odham Tribal Coordinating Committee be adopted as official
12 comments of the Tohono O'Odham Nation in regards to the development of
13 the Memorandum Agreement between the Bureau of Indian Affairs and the
14 Indian Health Service.



16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council urges the
17 inclusion of these comments to insure tribal participation and leader-
18 ship in alcohol and drug abuse prevention activities.

19 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 5th
20 day of February, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
21 of 1518.5 for; -0- against; 121.5 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the
22 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitu-
23 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
24 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
25 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
26 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
