

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Establishment of membership of the Tribal Coordinating Committee
established in Resolution No. 15-87)

RES. NO. 53-87

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has recognized that alcohol and substance
2 abuse is a severe health and social problem facing the Tohono O'Odham;
3 and

5 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council passed Resolution No. 15-87,
6 declaring a "War on Alcoholism" and establishing a coordinating
7 committee to coordinate efforts among resources and programs to
8 develop an action plan; and

9 WHEREAS, successful development of a tribal action plan for reducing the in-
10 cidence of drug and alcohol abuse requires the input of many agencies
11 serving the Tohono O'Odham.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that
13 the membership on the Tribal Coordinating Committee be the directors
14 or supervisors of the following agencies or programs, or their chosen
15 representative:

- 16 1. Tohono O'Odham Community Health Department
- 17 2. Tohono O'Odham Human Services Department
- 18 3. Tohono O'Odham Police Department
- 19 4. O'Odham Detox
- 20 5. Tohono O'Odham Education Department
- 21 6. Indian Oasis School District
- 22 7. Sells Service Unit
- 23 8. Bureau of Indian Affairs - Sells Agency
- 24 9. Bureau of Indian Affairs - Education Department
- 25 10. Tohono O'Odham Judicial Services

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the membership on the Tribal Coordinating Committee
27 include representation from the Bureau of Indian Affairs Agency School
28 Board.

29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the chairmanship of this coordinating committee be
30 jointly held by Ned Norris, Assistant Director of Tohono O'Odham Human
31 Services Department and Stephen Wall, Behavioral Health Coordinator
32 of Tohono O'Odham Community Health Department.

The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 5th
day of February, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
of 1359.0 for; 217.0 against; 64.0 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the
powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (b) of Article VI of the Constitu-
tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on

(January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
