

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(CDBG - Sif Oidak)

RES. NO. 54-87

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation did solicit the participation of the eleven  
2 political districts of the Tohono O'Odham Reservation for priority  
3 needs of their respective districts; and


4 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation did receive a proposal from Sif Oidak  
5 District for a prospective project, namely: Sif Oidak District Egg  
6 Production Complex; and

7 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council has determined it is in the  
8 best interest to apply for CDBG Program funds for the purpose of the  
9 above project.


10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that  
11 it hereby directs and authorizes the Chairman, Vice-Chairman, to  
12 consult with and negotiate for CDBG funding and to execute any and all  
13 contracts and legal documents and any amendments thereto which may be  
14 necessary to implement the project.

16 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 6th  
17 day of February, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
18 of 1581.5 for; -0- against; 58.5 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the  
19 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (j) of Article VI of the Constitu-  
20 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on  
21 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
22 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act  
23 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


