RES. NO. 56-87

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation of Arizona has submitted an application for  
2 a grant under the Community Development Block Grant Program for Indian  
3 Tribes; and


4 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation elects to submit demographic data that are  
5 unpublished and not generally available in order to meet the require-  
6 ments of the application process.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED IN ACCORDANCE WITH 24 CFR 571-300 (c) THAT:


- 8 1. Generally available, published data are substantially inaccurate  
9 or incomplete.
- 10 2. The data provided have been collected systematically.
- 11 3. Data are, to the greatest extent feasible, independently  
12 verifiable.
- 13 4. Data differentiates between reservation and BIA service  
14 area populations.

15 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 6th  
16 day of February, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
17 of 1640.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the  
18 powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitu-  
19 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on  
January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act  
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).



either approve or disapprove it within 48 hours of submittal.


