

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Accepting Farm Board's Recommendations)

RES. NO. 61-87

1 WHEREAS, the Farm Board presented to the Legislative Council the following
2 recommendation: that the district of San Xavier, Schuk Toak, Sif-
3 Oidak and San Lucy each have membership on the board since they are
4 involved in the CAP water; and

5 WHEREAS, further discussion amended the recommendation to include Chukut Kuk
6 District giving up one of their membership on the Farm Board.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council approves the Farm
8 Board's recommendation to allow the district of San Xavier, Schuk
9 Toak, Sif Oidak and San Lucy to have membership on the Farm Board
10 since they are all involved with CAP water.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the recommendation be amended to include Chukut Kuk
13 District giving up one membership on the Board.

14 The foregoing resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 6th
15 day of February, 1987, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
16 of 945.0 for; 356.0 against; 128.0 not voting; and 211.0 absent, pursuant to
17 the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (b) of Article VI of the Consti-
18 tution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
19 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
20 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
21 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
