1 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council reviewed the agenda for their February 9, 1987
2 Council meeting pursuant to Section C (a) (approve or amend and adopt
3 the agenda) of their Policies and Procedures; and

4 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council determined that the agenda should be amended

15 tion of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
